<u>From the LGBTQ+ Taskforce</u>: Due to the backlash over President Biden's first ever Proclamation on *Transgender Day of Visibility* which fell on Easter and publication of the new Vatican document, *Dignitas Infinita ("Infinite Dignity")*, we wish to share with you a letter written to Pope Francis by the mother of a transgender child. The new Vatican Document, which focuses on a range of "moral issues" (including the evils of war and poverty), while positive in some aspects, in the words of Francis DeBernardo, the executive director of New Way Ministries, again supports ideas that lead to real physical harm to transgender, nonbinary, and other LGBTQ+ people. In her letter, Lisa Williams, the Mom, writes, "I challenge us, as followers of Jesus, to allow ourselves to become uncomfortable so that real and necessary change can happen. We need to face our fears, our misunderstandings, and our biases. We must stop putting limits on God's love and divinity, which have no limits and are beyond our human understanding."

This Vatican document is the one our Fr. Fred referenced in his homily last weekend, which offers us all – like the Apostle's with their dissenting friend "doubting Thomas"– the challenge of remaining in communion even as we dispute the validity of aspects of the document. 
