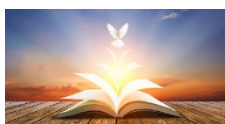
ALL are welcome & encouraged to participate in the *FOOD SENSE PROGRAM THROUGH OUR INTERFAITH FOOD CO-OP!* One of the Food Bank's longest running programs, *Food Sense* is a monthly food buying co-op for *ANYONE* who wants to stretch their grocery dollars. *Food Sense* provides a monthly box of 12-15 staple grocery items at a discounted price. There are no qualifications, no subscriptions, and no requirements to participate in *Food Sense*.

The Program is a “win-win,” as items are available at a steep discounted price due to the Food Bank’s massive bulk-rate buying power **and the funds from purchased monthly food boxes and specials go right back into the Food Bank** – helping to provide food for folks without financial means!

The Food Bank of CNY partners with sites across their 11-county service area, including our Interfaith Food Pantry housed at University United Methodist Church (324 University Ave). Each package costs \$20.50 without limitation to the number of packages you may buy. While the items vary from month to month, the package always includes: 4-5 meat items like chicken, ground beef or fish, 4-5 staple pantry items like pasta, soup, and rice, 2 fresh produce items like apples, carrots or oranges. Rotating monthly a-la-carte specials like stuffed pork chops, American cheese, meatballs, lasagna, and chicken tenders can be purchased in addition to the basic package, or on their own.

To order a package and/or monthly special items, go to <https://foodsense.foodbankcny.org/>, type in our Parish’s zip code, 13210, and choose UUMC Syracuse. From there, you can add the monthly package or any specials you would like to your cart. **Orders for the upcoming May box need to be placed by Fri, May 10 either online or in-person at University United Methodist Church. Pick up is Wed, May 22 from 4-6pm at University United Methodist Church (324 University Ave).** For more information or to set up a time to order in-person, contact our Food Pantry coordinator, Galyn Murphy-Stanley at 315-727-1231.

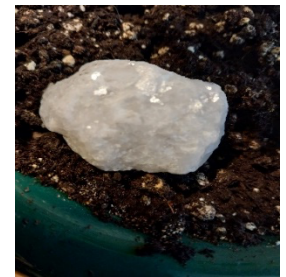
